Wireless Telegraphy. (Increased Power).

In accordance with a recommendation made on your behalf by the Radio Society of Great Britain, I am to inform you that a fresh licence will be issued for the station G6QM authorising power up to 10 (ten) watts on the band of frequencies 1720 to 1995 kc/s and up to 25 (twenty-five) watts on the remainder.

The charge for this licence is £1. licensing fee and £1. 10s. 0d. annual fee, but as you paid a licensing fee of 10s. on the grant of the 10 watt licence, the sum of 10s. only is now required in respect of this item.


The amount thus required (if payment is made immediately) is :-

Licensing fee	10s. 0d.
Annual fee	<u>£1. 10s. 0d.</u>
	<u>£2. 0s. 0d.</u>

If you will be good enough to forward the sum of £2. to the Comptroller and Accountant General, General Post Office, London, E.C.1, quoting reference W2/A.2562, a fresh licence will be issued.
